The speakers and topics include **Lynne Cox, University of Oxford** (Werner's syndrome); **Holly Van Remmen, University of Texas, USA** (oxidative stress and mitochondria); **David Wong, University of Liverpool** (surgery for macular degeneration); **Martin Bennett, Addenbrooke's Centre for Clinical Investigation** (Ageing and atherosclerosis).

The evening lecture will be given by **Nick Lane, Writer and Honorary Senior Research Fellow, University College London: Life, Death and Mitochondria.**

Professor Raymond Tallis, University of Manchester, has been invited to give the 2007 Lord Cohen Medal lecture.

Please send abstracts of your work for presentation at this meeting to Professor Janet Lord (J.M.Lord@bham.ac.uk) as a Word attachment in the following format:-

Title in Times New Roman or similar font, Size 12 Bold

Authors Names with presenting author underlined (Times New Roman, or similar in font size 12 normal)

Full Address including e-mail in Times New Roman or similar, font size 12 italic

Abstract of 250 words giving some background and results of study. Again use Times New Roman or similar font size 10 to 12 normal.

Abstracts will be read by 2 members of the BSRA Executive and 4 will be chosen for oral presentation. Delegates selected to give oral presentations will have their travel expenses paid by the BSRA.

Closing date for receipt of Abstracts and registration forms: **5pm June 1st 2007**

Authors will be notified before June 17th whether their work has been chosen for oral or poster presentation.
